Mailed or hand delivered paper entries will be charged a \$5.00 processing fee.

Admission policy for livestock exhibitors! After October 1, exhibitors who entered online will receive an e-mail with directions on printing a bar coded sheet for parking passes and admission wristbands. Exhibitors entering hard copies will receive similar bar coded sheets via US mail. All exhibitor households will receive two stickers for reserved livestock parking lots and 5 wristbands valid for show period entered. Parking stickers and wristbands can be picked up at the livestock entry gate upon presentation and scanning of the bar coded entry sheet.

A purebred class has been added. Registration papers must be presented, with matching ear notches, at check in.

CHECK IN:

Gilts must be in place by 5:00 PM, Thursday, October 13, 2016. Animals will not be allowed to enter barns until Thursday, October 13, 8:00 AM and inspected and passed by health officials. An approval card will be issued after inspection, prior to entering the barn.

SHOW DATE: Friday, October 14, 2016 at 5:00 PM

RELEASE TIME: Between 6:00 PM Saturday, October 15 and 8:00 AM, Sunday, October 16.

PARTICIPANTS:

Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2016, and residents of the state of North Carolina. Exhibitors must be able to exhibit animal on their own without any help. The NC State Fair requires that each exhibitor (individual, firm, or herd) possess a valid current PQA number prior to entry and follow PQA guidelines. Exhibitors under age 8 will show under parents PQA#.

ENTRY DEADLINE: September 15, 2016

ENTRIES:

Each exhibitor may exhibit a total of two gilts. Jr. Breeding Gilts must be owned by the exhibitor by September 1, 2016.

EXHIBITORS WILL CARE FOR THEIR ANIMALS UNTIL RELEASE TIME, Sunday, 7:00 AM. If any animal is not properly fed and watered, all premiums and sale proceeds from the NC State Fair will be withheld from the exhibitor.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The show is open to purebred or crossbred gilts born after March 1, 2016.

The NC State Fair requires that each exhibitor (individual, firm, or herd) possess a valid current PQA number prior to entry. Put the number on the back of the entry form or in the comment section online and follow PQA guidelines. Exhibitors under age 8 will show under parents PQA number.

No Oil or Powder to be used on Gilts. Gilts must have at least 1/2 inch of hair. Gilts clipped with less than 1/2 inch of hair will not be allowed to show in the breeding classes or sold on the truck load. Junior exhibitors will be allowed to participate in showmanship just like the light or heavy disqualified animals. No clipping after check in.

Be sure to read the Health Regulations before entering. Except where noted, the general rules of the Fair and of the Livestock Department will apply and govern this Show.

No drenching is allowed, unless under the direct supervision of a licensed veterinarian in the state of NC, with a valid medical reason.
